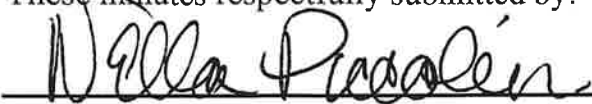
ADJOURNMENT
