NEW BUSINESS

Township Budget Appropriation Ordinance:

Trustee Hillary Kurzawa read the Frankfort Township budget ordinance for Fiscal Year 2027. A certified copy is attached to the minutes. The budget was read by Supervisor Nick George at the Frankfort Township budget hearing, June 8 at 6:30 p.m. The budget is balanced and meets all of the township's financial obligations. A motion was made to approve the budget by Trustee Kurzawa and seconded by Trustee Kot. The following roll call was taken:

Highway Budget Appropriation Ordinance:

The highway budget appropriation ordinance was presented at the public hearing. A motion was made by Trustee Smith and seconded by Trustee Kurzawa to approve the highway budget. Highway Road commissioner Bill Carlson walked us through the highway budget at the Frankfort Township Highway budget hearing on June 8 at 6:45 p.m. The budget meets all obligations and is balanced. The budget is attached. The following roll call was taken:

BOARD COMMENT

Assessor Joe Kral reported that Will County came to the township for a senior freeze event and they serviced 300 seniors that day. He also attended the volunteer lunch for the food pantry volunteers and it was really fantastic, and we really appreciate the volunteers!

Bill Carlson said branch pickup is ongoing. They haven't had mulch for 3 weeks – they have delivered complimentary mulch to between 150-200 people and there are 135 on the waiting list but they don't have enough mulch to fulfill those requests now. It is a complimentary program.

Also they were happy that bids for road repairs came in under the official estimate, and they will be repairing and replacing curbs and sidewalks near St. Francis Road and Pine Hill beginning June 15 and expect to complete all in 90 days.

Trustee Dave Smith wished everyone a Happy Father's Day coming up and said remember to put a flag up for Flag Day. Trustee Kurzawa also wished a Happy Father's Day and a Happy 4th of July this 250th year of our country.

Supervisor Nick George said they are supposed to be pouring the foundation for the columbarium at the Frankfort Township Cemetery but have experienced weather delays. The columbarium itself is coming from India which is delayed as well. They already have 15 people on the list to purchase niches. There is room to put up more columbarium when this is full. There will be a discounted price for Frankfort Township residents – they are still determining the price they will charge. Each columbarium has 48 niches. They will notify Kurz and Vandenburg funeral homes of the columbarium.

The Fourth of July parade is coming up and everyone is invited to walk with Frankfort Township. We are waiting on Will County permits for the food pantry –permitting is in the land use department now. They are 5 weeks behind schedule. The builder estimates 260 days to complete once they begin.

ADJOURNMENT

Trustee Kot made a motion to adjourn. Trustee Smith seconded the motion.

Upon taking the vote, all members voted aye, nays, none. Motion carried. The meeting closed at 7:19 p.m.
