Highway Commissioner – Tickets are now being issued by the Sheriff's deputies for cars parked on the street and impeding the snowplows. The township still has salt for road clearance and has now started to use that in the dome. We have another 2,000 pounds on order and the availability of more if needed.

Supervisor – This township has ZERO TOLERANCE for those who would imply that we are intolerant of religious diversity and people of color. The Village of Mokena had the signs with swastikas removed and changed within the hour of their defacing, and yet pictures of these signs were posted online and the news media was called. The Village of Mokena and Frankfort Township were victims of a smear campaign.
