**BOARD COMMENTS**

Highway Commissioner Bill Carlson, announced that the branch pickup program will start on May 6<sup>th</sup>.

Assessor Joe Kral, updated the board on the senior freeze exemption. You can apply for the senior freeze assessment on your property if your total household income is \$65,000 or less and you are above 65 years old. On April 22<sup>nd</sup> the County will host a senior freeze day at Frankfort Township to help seniors fill out the forms.

Supervisor Moustis, gave a synopsis of Bill 3301 filed by Representative Natalie Manley that would eliminate Will County Township Clerks. It amends the Township Code. It provides that on the effective date of the amendatory act, the office of township clerk in each township of Will County is eliminated and the term of each elected or appointed township clerk is terminated. It also provides that the powers and responsibilities of each township clerk are transferred to the Will County Clerk.

The Event Center is doing well with many bookings. The Township has a list of preferred vendors for catering.

**ADJOURNMENT**


Trustee George made a motion to adjourn. Trustee Griffin seconded the motion.
