Highway Commissioner – Road resurfacing is complete. New trees have been purchased to replace those that perished from winter kill. There are 260/300 trees on standby order with a local nursery. The township branch pickup program began on the first Monday in May and will continue to the last Monday in October. There are five culverts in Ironwood that need replacing. Bids have been let for same. This project falls under the Motor Fuel Tax program which is handled totally by the County of Will. Our Motor Fuel tax money accumulates until a project qualifies for the use of this money. The free mulch bin is now down to about a truckload full.

Supervisor – Our new Township Event Center is hosting an Open House this Saturday, May 29, 2015, from 11 a.m. until 2 p.m. Changes have been made to the rental of this facility...rent the full upstairs rooms or the downstairs rooms alone or with the patio, or rent the entire facility.

Trustees: Trustee Griffin attended the VFW Memorial Day Ceremony with the 21 gun salute at our service monument and our township cemetery. There has been some discussion with the local VFW about moving the monument to their property at the corner of Sauk Trail and Pfeiffer Road, but no action at this time.
